The Gannett Grill – widely known throughout Wyoming for its good food, wide selection of lunch and dinner items, informal atmosphere and outdoor deck – is easily the most popular restaurant in town, frequented by locals and tourists alike. The grill’s extensive menu includes:

- Delicious, 12-inch, New York-style, hand-tossed pizzas that are made from scratch and cooked on stone in the grill’s pizza ovens.
- Juicy burgers made from local beef cattle raised free of hormones and antibiotics by Wyoming Hudson Meats.
- Salads and entrees prepared with delicious, homegrown vegetables – including arugula, asparagus, broccolini, carrots, cherry tomatoes and butternut squash – from an onsite organic garden.
- An extensive array of sandwiches and bar munchies.

Beer lovers can step into the adjoining Lander Bar and purchase one of the delicious, homemade microbrews from the Lander Brewing Company. These beers are made using only the finest ingredients from around the world and include microbrews that have won national and international awards at the Great American Beer Festival, the World Beer Cup and other competitions.

The grill prides itself on providing good food in a fun, family-friendly atmosphere. A kids menu is available, tailored specifically to youngsters.

Indoor seating at rustic wooden tables is offered year round. In the summer, outdoor seating is available on the grill’s spacious deck, shaded by a 100-year-old pine tree. The outdoor deck is the center of many popular local celebrations, including the International Climbers Festival, the Lander Brew Festival and the Fourth of July.

The menu and food at the grill are prepared under the supervision of Chef Geoff Rader – previously the executive chef at Cowfish.

The Gannett Grill works closely with the other four establishments that form the Coalter Block restaurant group – Cowfish, the Lander Brewing Company, the Lander Bar and the Scream Shack – to offer locals and tourists a selection of dining experiences all year round.

Established in 1996, the restaurant is located on the Coalter Block on Main Street in downtown Lander, between First and Second Streets. Parking is available on the street out front and in parking lots alongside of and in back of the Coalter Block establishments.
